Buchanan, who is attached to the General Staff, M.D. No. 2, that Captain M.P. Kelley, Officer i/c Bombing, was holding the twelfth, it being understood that you would call at his office for same. I have no doubt, therefore, that you will receive the medal if you make application to Captain Kelley.
